## 1. Scholarship Application

This is the "Peace Love and Happiness" Scholarship. Application. for the academic year 2021 - 2022.

The Grateful Hippie Foundation Inc. is sponsoring a "Peace Love and Happiness" Scholarship. The scholarship offering is for legal residents of the United States who are accepted to or enrolled in a 2- or 4-year undergraduate program at an accredited college, university, trade school, technical school, or vocational school located within their community in the US for the academic year 2021 - 2022.

Applications will be accepted mail only. All applications (as defined below) are subject to the below Rules and Regulations.

## 2. Agreement to Rules and Regulations

When you submit an application for a Scholarship (as defined below), you are fully and unconditionally agreeing that you will be bound by the following Rules and Regulations. The complete application includes eight (8) parts as follows:

- part 1: Contact Information
- part 2: Parent Information (required for minors)
- part 3: Liability and Publicity Release upon acceptance.
- part 4: Letter of Recommendation from any nonrelated teacher, community leader or volunteer sponsor.
- part 5: Personal Essay 500 words. Please pick one of the two questions posed and tell us your answer.
- part 6: Proof of Income and receiving public assistance at this time.
- part 7: High School diploma / G.E.D.
- part 8. Household information

### 3. Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for a “peace, love and happiness scholarship”, you must meet the following criteria:

- Students enrolled in a graduate program are **not** eligible for this scholarship.
- Be a legal resident of one of the fifty (50) United States or the District of Columbia.
- Be accepted to or enrolled in a 2- or 4-year undergraduate program at an accredited community college, university, trade school, technical school, or vocational school located in the United States as defined by the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.
- Live in a single parent home.
- Receive public benefits
- Have H.S. Diploma or G.E.D.
- Male or Female at least 16 years’ old
- Living at home with single parent while attending school the scholarship would be used to pay for.
